## Food Bank Hosts Summer Lunch Program

Good nutrition is essential for effective learning all year long. Just as learning does not end when school lets out, neither does the need for good nutrition. Children who aren't hungry learn better, act better, and feel better. The Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) is federally funded by the USDA and is targeted at ending childhood hunger. SFSP incorporates an after school snack program during the school year and a meals program during the summer break.

Hawthorne Elementary is a site where free meals are available to children and youth 0-18 years old. Lunch is served from 11:45 a.m. - 12:45 p.m. on Mondays through Thursday only. Program ends July 21, 2016.
