CALLING ALL BUS RIDERS!

Closed Campus Safety Protocols

In an effort to maintain a secure environment for all students and school staff all gates, except for the main gate near the front office, will be locked directly after school starts at 8:15 until just before the majority of our students are released at 2:30.

This may require some to stop into the office to make our staff aware of your being on campus to pick up a child or escorting a student who may be arriving after the start of the school day.

We would also like to remind all parents that with the exception of the PEEP program or Ms. Miller Preschool families, no parents should remain on campus after the start of the school day. All parents or volunteers must sign in with the front office and be issued a visitor/volunteer badge each day you visit our campus.
