From our School Nurse:

Allergies have come to San Luis Obispo with the arrival of Spring. If your child is experiencing the symptoms of what appears to be a cold; sneezing, clear runny nose, coughing, itchy nose or throat or red eyes, seasonal allergies might be to blame. Medicines can help to ease allergy symptoms.



Any medication brought to school can only be dispensed by the school nurse or other designated staff. This means your child should not be carrying medication in their backpacks or pockets. These include medications such as rescue inhalers for asthma, cough drops, Advil, Tylenol or any over the counter drug. Please do not send your child to school with medicine.

If your child needs to receive medication while at school Only medical doctors are authorized to direct the use of medication on a school campus. Parents can pick up a Medication Consent Form from the school office to complete along with their child's doctor. Return this completed form to the school office along with the prescription or over-the-counter medication.

CAASPP Testing begins Monday, May 7th. Please make every effort to NOT schedule medical appointments or vacations during this time. Parents will receive a notice from your child's teacher with test dates and times. Below is partial schedule:
